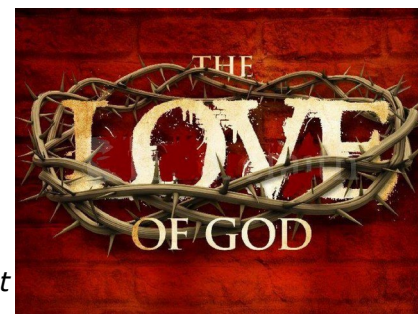

I want the best for My children, just as parents want too.

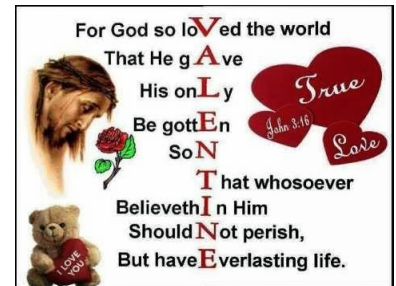
Whatever you do in life, whether you walk in love or not;
