With peace and perfect rest.

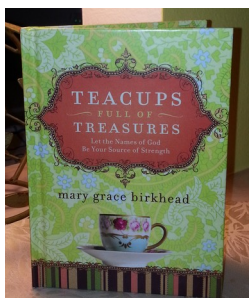
