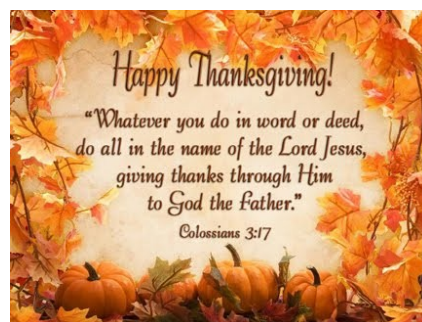
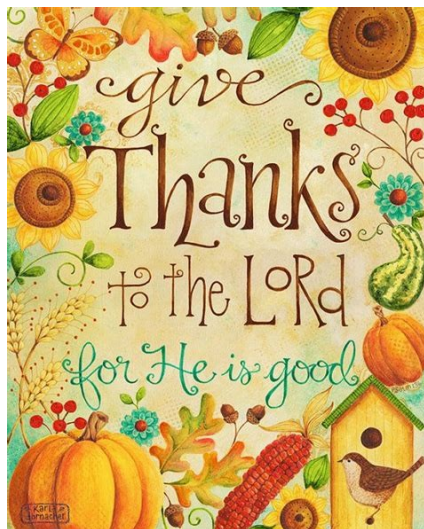

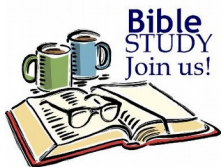

The girl began saying "hi" to Tony as she traveled to and from her workplace. Soon enough they were having small conversations and then regular talks and periodic lunches. *"Tony tells me about his war stories, loved ones, and who should win the Super Bowl." "I tell Tony about my problems, loved ones, and how I don't really care who should win the Super Bowl."*

From an outsider's point of view, it seemed the young girl was offering the old, lonely man an ear. But the friendship was reciprocal. When the girl was going through a difficult period emotionally, Tony reportedly helped her navigate those tough personal choices.
