Pastor's Message

Luke 12:24 Consider the ravens: They do not sow or reap, they have no storeroom or barn; yet God feeds them. And how much more valuable you are than birds!

Whether we admit it to ourselves or not, we are consumed by anxiety. That is why we have stomach ulcers, are overweight and cannot sleep at night. These are among the signs of worry and stress. I will admit it, I am anxious about things, and I overeat (as though that really helps!)

In the Gospel for August 4th, *Luke 12:22-40*, the Lord comforts us with the knowledge that He has created this world and all that is in it and that He is still controlling it. No matter what man has done to *God's* creation, no matter how much man rebels against *God*, and no matter how man worries about collecting security for the future, *God* is still 100% in control.

He is in control of the entire universe and galaxies, stars and planets, each individual creature and plant on these planets. All the way down to the very things that make up the things that make up atoms that make everything. His almighty power alone continues to make even our atoms function as they are meant to.

John hated to fly. He was scared to death of flying. One day he received a phone call from his son, Robert, who lived across the country. It seems Robert needed a life saving operation and wanted his dad to come right away and be at his side.

With fear and trepidation, John booked the first flight to see his son. He took his seat on the plan, and as soon as the wheels lifted off the ground, John began to lift himself from his seat by pushing against the armrests. John was helping the plane to fly by carrying some of his own weight.

Ridiculous, right?! How often we try to carry our own weight with the *God* who personally makes every little thing work in the heavens and on earth. *God* cares for the ravens who do not plant anything or harvest anything. How much more valuable we are to *God* than ravens! *God* is willing to carry the entire load.

Lord, God. Cause me to remember that You are intimately involved in my life. You know my needs. You know what concerns me most. You know what worries me. Remove those things that distract me from knowing You to be my all powerful Father. You love me to the point that you gave up Your Son to removed my greatest fear...eternal death. All praise to You, Father, Son and Holy Spirit. Amen.
